Re: Economic Development and Job Creation Initiative – Invitation to Nominate Start Up or Early or Stage Company.

Dear [REDACTED]:

The purpose of this letter is to invite you, as we have other leaders, to nominate a start up, early or second stage company for this Firm’s Economic Development and Job Creation Initiative (“EDJCI”). The Firm continues to be concerned about the economic present and the economic future of the [REDACTED] community. Typically, the nominations greatly exceed the number of companies to which the EDJCI can commit. There will be extensive due diligence, evaluation and vetting of each qualified nominee. The Firm will keep you posted regarding your nominee(s). Nominations will be reviewed in quarterly cycles.

The EDJCI is one small way in which this Firm hopes to contribute to the economic health and future of the community.
